FUND COMMENT:
 March saw the strategy underperform its benchmark, returning -0.43% against the benchmark's 0.39%. The strategy has, however, outperformed its benchmark since inception with a total return of 21.89% against the benchmark's 20.77%.

In terms of individual fund performance against the benchmark, the Investec Trio Fund underperformed the benchmark during March while the Orbis Optimal Fund outperformed during the month. The Investec Trio Fund has performed negatively over the last 6 months and this has impacted on its longer term performance.

The overall risk of the portfolio is low relative to that of the MSCI World Equity Index and the correlations of the underlying funds are very low, adding to the diversification within the strategy.

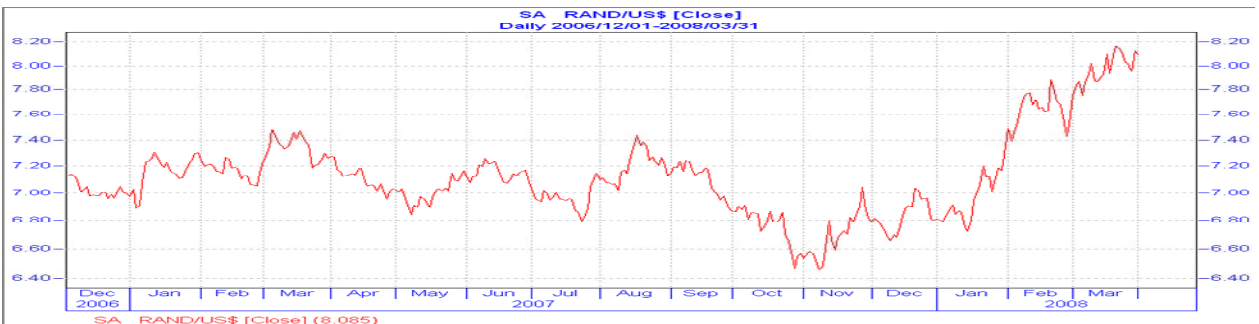
FUND COMMENT:

March saw the strategy underperform its benchmark, returning -0.53% against the benchmark's 0.55%. The strategy has, however, outperformed its benchmark since inception with a total return of 37.54% against the benchmark's 27.60%.

In terms of individual fund performance against the benchmark, both the underlying funds managed to underperform the benchmark during March. The Orbis Global Equity Fund was the better performing fund, returning -0.37%. The Trialpha Growth Strategy has been removed from the portfolio and will not be replaced in the short term.

The overall risk of the portfolio is low relative to that of the MSCI World Equity Index and the correlation of the underlying funds are low, adding diversification within the strategy.
